**A. CALL TO ORDER**

The Regular Board Meeting of the Central Parc Community Development District (the “District”) was called to order at 2:00 p.m. in the offices at 19503 S. West Villages Parkway, #A4, Venice, Florida 34293.

**B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION**

Proof of publication was presented which showed that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Sarasota Herald Tribune* on May 6, 2022, as legally required.

**C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM**

**D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA**

A **motion** was made by Mr. Gerenger, seconded by Mr. Landers and passed unanimously amending today’s meeting agenda to include Consider Appointment of New Supervisor to Seat #3.

**E. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**1. August 31, 2021, Public Hearing & Regular Board Meeting**

A **motion** was made by Mr. Blucher, seconded by Mr. Landers and passed unanimously approving the minutes of the August 31, 2021, Public Hearing & Regular Board Meeting, as presented.

**F. OLD BUSINESS**

There were no Old Business items to come before the Board.

**G. NEW BUSINESS**

**1. Consider Resolution No. 2022-01 – Designating a Seat Number for Appointed Board Member Jim Blucher**

Resolution No. 2022-01 was presented, entitled:

**RESOLUTION 2022-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE CENTRAL PARC COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DESIGNATING A SEAT NUMBER FOR APPOINTED BOARD MEMBER JIM BLUCHER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Mr. Blucher was appointed as a Supervisor at the June 30, 2021, meeting. At that time the Board did not clearly designate the specific seat to be filled by Supervisor Blucher. This resolution appoints Supervisor Blucher to Seat 2, which carries a four year term.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Gerenger, seconded by Mr. Blucher and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2022-01, as presented.

**2. Consider Resolution No. 2022-02 – Extending the Terms of Office of Current Supervisors to Coincide with General Election**

Resolution No. 2022-02 was presented, entitled:

**RESOLUTION 2022-02**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE CENTRAL PARC COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT EXTENDING THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF ALL CURRENT SUPERVISORS TO COINCIDE WITH THE GENERAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 190.006, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Seat 1, currently held by Mark Gerenger; Seat 2, currently held by James Blucher, which terms will be extended to coincide with the General Election, when required. Seat 5, currently held by Sean Landers and Seats 3 and 4, which are currently vacant, will also have their terms extended to coincide with the General Election, when required.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Gerenger, seconded by Mr. Landers and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2022-02, as presented.

**3. Consider Resolution No. 2022-03 – Adopting Prompt Payment Policies and Procedures**

Resolution No. 2022-03 was presented, entitled:

**RESOLUTION 2022-03**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE CENTRAL PARC COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ADOPTING PROMPT PAYMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 218, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

It was noted that it would be in the best interest of the District to establish prompt payment policies and procedures for vendors and contractors providing certain goods and/or services to the District. These policies and procedures are necessary in order to conduct District business and will remain in full force until the Board should amend or replace them from time to time.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Blucher, seconded by Mr. Landers and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2022-03, as presented.

**4. Consider Resolution No. 2022-04 – Setting the Landowners’ Meeting**

Resolution No. 2022-04 was presented, entitled:

**RESOLUTION 2022-04**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE CENTRAL PARC COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DESIGNATING A DATE, TIME AND LOCATION FOR A LANDOWNERS’ MEETING AND ELECTION; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; ESTABLISHING FORMS FOR THE LANDOWNER ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

The District is statutorily required to hold a meeting of the landowners of the District for the purpose of electing Board Supervisors on the first Tuesday in November. This Resolution designates November 1, 2022, as the landowners’ election and establishes forms that will be used in that meeting and election, specifically the legal advertisement, meeting instructions, landowner proxy, and official ballot.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Blucher, seconded by Mr. Landers and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2022-04, as presented.

**5. Consider Acquisition Agreement between the District and Sabal Trace Development Partners, LLC**

A **motion** was made by Mr. Gerenger, seconded by Mr. Blucher and passed unanimously approving the Acquisition Agreement between the District and Sabal Trace Development Partners, LLC, in substantial form, in order to allow developer’s counsel time to review and upon approval, can be executed by Supervisor Jim Blucher on behalf of the District.

**6. Consider Resolution No. 2022-05 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Proposed Budget**

Resolution No. 2022-05 was presented, entitled:

## RESOLUTION 2022-05

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE CENTRAL PARC COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023 AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON PURSUANT TO FLORIDA LAW; ADDRESSING TRANSMITTAL, POSTING AND PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS; ADDRESSING SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

A **motion** was made by Mr. Gerenger, seconded by Mr. Landers and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2022-05, as presented, setting the public hearing to consider the final budget for July 19, 2022, at 2:00 PM at the offices of Special District Services located at 19503 S West Villages Parkway Venice, Florida 34293 in the meeting room across from Suite #A14.

#### **7. Consider Appointment of New Supervisor**

A motion was made by Mr. Gerenger seconded by Mr. Landers and passed unanimously appointing Jonathan Hunter to Seat #3.

Mr. Hunter was sworn in and joined the other Supervisors. Mr. Haber explained the duties and responsibilities of a Supervisor, including Sunshine laws and public records.

**RESOLUTION 2022-06**

**THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION OF THE CENTRAL PARC COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT (“DISTRICT”) RELATING TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023; AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the District Manager has, prior to the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) day in June, 2022, submitted to the Board of Supervisors (“**Board**”) of the Central Parc Community Development District (“**District**”) proposed budget (“**Proposed Budget**”) for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023 (“**Fiscal Year 2022/2023**”) along with an explanatory and complete financial plan for each fund of the District, pursuant to the provisions of Section 190.008(2)(a), *Florida Statutes*; and

**WHEREAS**, at least sixty (60) days prior to the adoption of the Proposed Budget, the District filed a copy of the Proposed Budget with the local governing authorities having jurisdiction over the area included in the District pursuant to the provisions of Section 190.008(2)(b), *Florida Statutes*; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board set a public hearing thereon and caused notice of such public hearing to be given by publication pursuant to Section 190.008(2)(a), *Florida Statutes*; and

**WHEREAS**, the District Manager posted the Proposed Budget on the District’s website at least two days before the public hearing; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 190.008(2)(a), *Florida Statutes*, requires that, prior to October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, the Board, by passage of the Annual Appropriation Resolution, shall adopt a budget for the ensuing fiscal year and appropriate such sums of money as the Board deems necessary to defray all expenditures of the District during the ensuing fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the District Manager has prepared a Proposed Budget, whereby the budget shall project the cash receipts and disbursements anticipated during a given time period, including reserves for contingencies for emergency or other unanticipated expenditures during the fiscal year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE CENTRAL PARC COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:**

**SECTION 1. BUDGET**

- a. The Board has reviewed the Proposed Budget, a copy of which is on file with the office of the District Manager and at the District’s Local Records Office, and hereby approves certain amendments thereto, as shown in Section 2 below.

- b. The Proposed Budget, attached hereto as **Exhibit “A,”** as amended by the Board, is hereby adopted in accordance with the provisions of Section 190.008(2)(a), *Florida Statutes (“Adopted Budget”)*, and incorporated herein by reference; provided, however, that the comparative figures contained in the Adopted Budget may be subsequently revised as deemed necessary by the District Manager to reflect actual revenues and expenditures.
- c. The Adopted Budget, as amended, shall be maintained in the office of the District Manager and at the District’s Local Records Office and identified as “The Budget for the Central Parc Community Development District for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 2023.”
- d. The Adopted Budget shall be posted by the District Manager on the District’s official website within thirty (30) days after adoption, and shall remain on the website for at least 2 years.

**SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS**

There is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the District, for Fiscal Year 2022/2023, the sum of \$101,531 to be raised by the levy of assessments and/or otherwise, which sum is deemed by the Board to be necessary to defray all expenditures of the District during said budget year, to be divided and appropriated in the following fashion:

TOTAL GENERAL FUND	\$ <u>101,531</u>
TOTAL ALL FUNDS	\$ <u>101,531</u>

**SECTION 3. BUDGET AMENDMENTS**

Pursuant to Section 189.016, *Florida Statutes*, the District at any time within Fiscal Year 2022/2023 or within 60 days following the end of the Fiscal Year 2022/2023 may amend its Adopted Budget for that fiscal year as follows:

- a. A line-item appropriation for expenditures within a fund may be decreased or increased by motion of the Board recorded in the minutes, and approving the expenditure, if the total appropriations of the fund do not increase.
- b. The District Manager or Treasurer may approve an expenditure that would increase or decrease a line-item appropriation for expenditures within a fund if the total appropriations of the fund do not increase and if either (i) the aggregate change in the original appropriation item does not exceed the greater of \$15,000 or 15% of the original appropriation, or (ii) such expenditure is authorized by separate disbursement or spending resolution.

- c. Any other budget amendments shall be adopted by resolution and consistent with Florida law.

The District Manager or Treasurer must ensure that any amendments to the budget under paragraph c. above are posted on the District’s website within 5 days after adoption and remain on the website for at least 2 years.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
